

Comprehensive Event Day FAQ Guide

Venue & Location

Where is the event being held?

The event takes place at the **Ng Teng Fong Centre for Healthcare Innovation**. The exact address is 11 Jalan Tan Tock Seng, Singapore 308433.

How do I get to the venue?

The Ng Teng Fong Centre for Healthcare Innovation is accessible via:

- **MRT:** Novena **MRT station (NS21)** is the nearest station, approximately a 10-minute walk.
- **Bus:** Services **21, 124, 130, 131, 139, 145, 190** stop near the venue.
- **Car:** The venue is located near the junction of **Jalan Tan Tock Seng** and **Moulmein Road**.

Transportation & Parking

Where can I park my vehicle?

Parking is available at the Ng Teng Fong Centre For Healthcare Innovation car park.

Are parking coupons provided?

No, parking coupons will not be issued for this event.

What are the parking rates?

Standard parking rates are \$2.40 per hour on Mondays to Saturday, and \$2.40 per entry on Sunday and Public Holiday.

Is valet parking available?

No, valet services are not available.

Are there drop-off points?

Yes, there is a designated drop-off point at the main entrance of the Ng Teng Fong Centre for Healthcare Innovation.

Registration & Check-in

When should I arrive?

We recommend arriving **30-45 minutes before the event starts** to allow time to breeze through registration, grab a good seat and enjoy some light breakfast while networking. Doors to the auditorium open 30 minutes before the programme begins.

Where is the registration desk?

The registration desk is located at Level 2 and Level 4 of the Ng Teng Fong Centre for Healthcare Innovation. You can easily get there by taking the escalator to the levels or lift at Lobby A or C.

What do I need for check-in?

Please show the QR code from your confirmation email. The QR code is your event ticket. As we are implementing a virtual badge system, you will require your mobile device to check-in to the conference.

How does the check-in process work?

Show your QR code at registration. Staff will scan it and you will gain access to the auditorium and your virtual badge on the spot.

I didn't receive my QR code. What should I do?

Check your spam folder. If you still could not locate your QR code or confirmation email, head to the registration desk. Our staff will verify your identity using your name and email.

What if I lost or forgot my QR code. Can I still enter the event?

Yes. No worries - just head to our registration counter; and our team will assist you. We'll verify your identity using your name and email.

Can I transfer my registration to someone else?

Any transfer of registration has to be done before the conference. Kindly email conference@chi.sg with the new attendee's details, and we'll update the registration, subject to the event organiser's approval.

How do I cancel my registration?

Email conference@chi.sg with your name and your request to cancel. Our team will process your cancellation and inform you once it's complete.

Can I register on-site on the event day?

Unfortunately, onsite ticket purchase will not be available on the event day. Kindly purchase the conference ticket before the 4th July 2025, 23:59 SGT.

What is the dress code for the event?

Will I be assigned seating for sessions?
